

Applications for Registration of on-Campus Parking

Students can drive a car, motorcycle or bicycle onto the campus. If you wish to drive a car or motorcycle, you must register your vehicle at university.

Residents of on-campus dormitories are not allowed to use car / motorcycle for commuting, yet they can park their car/ motorcycle in the parking area in front of dormitory etc. For this parking, they need to register the car/ motorcycle as other students do.

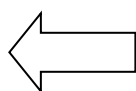
Application for the registration can be made after enrollment as below.

●For Car/Motorcycle Registration

Access the University website from the university's PC Room, or through the internal LAN, and apply for registration for parking on the application page linked from the university intranet page after your enrollment. **In order to drive a car in Japan, you must purchase voluntary insurance.**

***To apply for the "Parking Registration and Vehicle Information Content" Google Form, you need to log in using your stn email account.**

★ Required for Application

- Your driver's license	A foreign driving license and international driving permit are not accepted.
- Vehicle inspection certificate (<i>Syaken-syo</i>)	*Only for the registration of car or motorcycle over 400cc.
- A certificate of voluntary insurance	*The mandatory vehicle liability insurance is not voluntary insurance."

●Parking Bicycle on Campus

It is not necessary for registration of bicycle on campus. However, students are only permitted to park a bicycle with ownership and security registration (*Bohan-toroku*). Ownership and security registration can be completed at a bicycle retailer, DIY store or other retailers where you bought your bicycle. Also, enrollment in bicycle casualty insurance is mandatory in Niigata Prefecture since October 1, 2022. If you use a bicycle, please check "Check Sheet for Enrollment in Bicycle Insurance" attached and make sure that you are enrolled in bicycle casualty insurance. If you are not enrolled, please enroll in bicycle casualty insurance. If you enroll in Comprehensive Insurance for Students Lives Coupled with "Gakkensai", you will be covered if you involve in a bicycle accident.
